CAUTION CODES

- Y1 Is guilty of unsporting behaviour
- Y2 Shows dissent by word or action
- Y3 Persistently infringes the Laws of the Game
- Y4 Delays the restart of play
- Y5 Fails to respect the required distance when play is restarted with a corner kick or free kick
- Y6 Enters or re-enters the field of play without the Referee's permission
- Y7 Deliberately leaves the field of play without the Referee's permission

SEND OFF CODES

- R1 Is guilty of serious foul play
(an offence on the ball against an opponent)
- R2 Is guilty of violent conduct (an offence off the ball)
- R3 Spits at an opponent or any other person
- R4 Denies an opponent a goal or an obvious goal scoring opportunity by deliberately handling the ball
- R5 Denies an obvious goal scoring opportunity to an opponent moving towards the player's goal by an offence punishable by a free kick or penalty kick
- R6 Uses offensive, insulting or abusive language or an indecent gesture
- R7 Receives a second caution in the same match

Summary of Rules

Players must be female who do not turn 16 or older any time this year.

Games are 30 minute halves with injury time.

If needed, extra time is ten minute halves plus injury time with no interval.

Extra time is golden goal.

During extra time, one player is removed from each team after 5, 10, and 15 minutes during a dead ball situation.

All players on the team sheet can be utilised on unlimited interchange.

Only players on the field at the end of extra time can participate in kicks from the penalty mark.

It is strongly recommended that referees have no association with either school.
