**As the Bill Turner School Football Finals Series approaches let's take a look at this year's top four Trophy (Girls) teams.**

**From north to south: Kelvin Grove State College (Brisbane), Hunter Sports High (Gateshead - Lake Macquarie), Westfields Sports High (Fairfield - Sydney) and Holy Spirit College (Bellambi - Illawarra) are the four semi-finalists.**

**On Tuesday September 4 at the City of Lake Macquarie Regional Football Facility (SPEERS POINT NSW) the journey of these four teams takes them to the summit, where the 28th Bill Turner Trophy Champion will be crowned.**

About the four semi finalists:

**Kelvin Grove State College (Brisbane Qld)** will be playing at their first National Finals Series.

KG have beaten: Albany Creek SHS 4-3, Mt Alvernia College 5-0, Beaudesert SHS 5-0, Stanthorpe SHS 6-0, Chancellor State College 2/5-2/3 on penalties and Helensvale SHS 2-1.

**Holy Spirit College Bellambi (NSW)** first trip to the City of Lake Macquarie for the National Finals was in 2015 where they finished runners-up to Westfields Sports High. HS has beaten: Woonona High 3-0, Vincentia High 4-1, St Marys Star of the Sea 2-0, Bathurst Campus 2-1 and Marian College Griffith 2-1.

**Hunter Sports High** is located at Gateshead in the City of Lake Macquarie and is another of the most successful schools in the history of the tournament having won the Bill Turner Trophy in 2005, 2006, 2007, 2011 and 2013 and will be contesting their **15th CONSECUTIVE** Bill Turner Trophy National Final Series.

HSH has beaten: CC Wallsend 10-0, Lambton High 4-0, Maitland Grossmann 12-0 and Wollumbin High (Murwillumbah) 5-0.

**Westfields Sports High** from Sydney's south-west make their 17th National Finals Series. Westfields Sports High girls, like their brothers, are the most successful school in the tournament having hoisted the Bill Turner Trophy aloft on 11 occasions 1995, 1996, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2012, 2015 and 2017 and have been runners-up twice in 2011 and 2013.

WSH has beaten: Bossley Park 2-0, John Edmondson High 3-0, The Hills Sports 2-1 and Gosford High 3-0.
